WTTI BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

We expect that WTTI participants will:

1. Serve as alcohol, tobacco, drug and violence Prevention Advocates to make a positive difference in their schools and communities — after attending the conference.
2. Be respectful of others & willing to follow directions, while at the conference and beyond.
3. Be nice to others and will not put anyone down.
4. Arrive on time for the conference and will stay through graduation on Sunday afternoon. The program builds upon itself, and missed activities will leave participants feeling lost and unprepared.
5. Attend and be on time to all activities at the conference, including meals. **The Reason:** *Announcements, which are necessary to your day, are made at the beginning of most activities and meals. Being late delays the progress of the day, and may cause you to miss important information.*
6. Wear their name-tags at all activities and in a place where they can be easily seen (*not below your belt or inside your jacket*) — so that we can address everyone by name AND because your name-tag will contain important group assignment information.
7. Follow the rule where boys and girls are not allowed in each other's cabins. The only exception to this rule may occur during organized discussion group sessions called Family or Action Groups.
8. Not bring Cell phones, radios, tape decks, CD players and head-phones. We don't want participants distracted, nor do we want people to run the risk of having anything valuable lost.
9. Respect that alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and tobacco products are not allowed. Only prescribed or other doctor-approved medication is allowed at the conference.

Please Note: *Even though WTTI participants will be expected to be non-users, we will make a request asking those campers who are in possession of any illegal drugs, alcohol, cigarettes or potentially harmful items to turn them over to the WTTI staff upon arrival. If anyone is found with any of these items, he or she will risk being expelled. Parents or guardians of student violators will be called to advise them of the situation & to discuss how to proceed. Our goal is to provide a safe, drug-free environment for all.*

CONFERENCE RULES

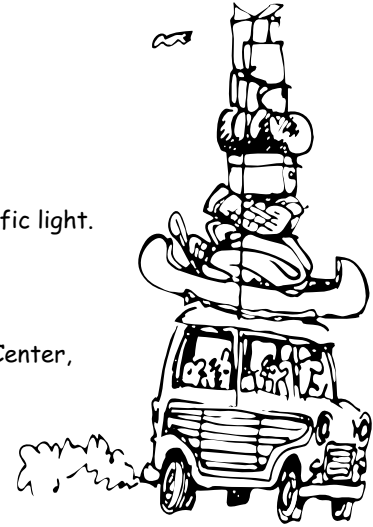
- For safety reasons, the lake and the dock are off limits.
- Again for safety reasons, no one may leave the designated camp areas unless he or she has been authorized to do so by the WTTI Director or Associate Director. Students must always be chaperoned by a staff member.
- The Camp Grounds will be respected by cleaning up any areas you use, placing trash in receptacles provided and following the camp's recycling procedures.
- Participants are responsible for setting up the dining room with plates, napkins & plastic wear. After eating, participants are expected to clean their tables by wiping them down and sweeping up under them. Please pick up any garbage that lands on the floor. When you leave the dining room, your table area should be spotless. Everyone at your table is responsible for making sure this happens.
- If you chew gum, please DO NOT drop any gum on the ground. Little animals — like squirrels — will eat it and have a high risk of choking to death. Please use the trash cans or don't bring gum at all.
- Remember that WTTI is responsible for any and all damages incurred to the camp site other than normal wear and tear. We have a reputation of leaving the camp cleaner than we arrive ... so help us keep that reputation! Thank you.

- Travel Rte. 80 West to Exit 12 (Blairstown/Hope).
- At bottom of ramp, bear to the RIGHT onto Rte. 521 N.
- Take Rte. 521 until it ends and you come to a "T".
- At "T", turn LEFT onto Rte. 94 South and travel a short distance to the first traffic light.
- At traffic light, turn RIGHT onto Bridge St. and take to stop sign on steep hill.
- At stop sign, turn right and continue up hill for 1 short block & then
- Bear LEFT onto Millbrook Rd.
- Travel on Millbrook (it will twist and wind) & when you pass Princeton Educational Center, you will know you are close.
- Make the next possible RIGHT onto Birch Ridge Rd.
- The camp is a little way down this road on the LEFT.
